Policies

Program The summer program operates for 11 weeks, with a different theme and educational program each week. You may enroll for the whole summer or you may choose individual weeks.

Age Groups Boys and girls who have completed Kindergarten through 6th Grade are eligible for the program. Children are placed in groups based on their age and grade in school with exceptions made when appropriate.

School Holidays Camp will be closed on July 3rd. Tuition amount will remain the same during that week.

Absences Please notify our office at (949) 854-7611 by 9 a.m. if your child will be absent. No refunds or make-up days can be made in case of absence or illness.

Lunch Snacks are provided. Children bring their lunches each day in a zip-lock bag with their name and date clearly marked. (Please, no lunch boxes.)

Dress Your child is required to wear his/her Turtle Rock T-Shirt every day. You will receive 1 free T-Shirt per child with registration. Extra T-Shirts can be ordered with your registration, or they may be purchased in the school office for \$12 each. We suggest baseball caps or other hats with brims to be worn as sun protection. Children are required to wear tennis shoes and socks daily. Sandals may be brought to school for special water play or beach days. On swim days, please send your child to school wearing his/her bathing suit and bring sandals in backpack.

Backpacks Your child is required to bring a back pack to school daily containing a change of clothing, towel, swimsuit, sandals, and disposable camera (optional). Sunscreen must be applied at home.

Clothing All clothing and items brought to school must be clearly marked with child's name.

Parent Meeting All parents must attend a Parent Orientation Meeting on June 10th from 5:30 - 6:30 p.m. for vital camp information. Children welcome to attend .

Enrollment Registration may be completed by filling out the attached registration forms and mailing them with your fee of \$30 per family. Registration fees are non-refundable. You can register for the whole summer or any number of weeks.

Tuition Policy Payments are due monthly, in advance, for the weeks of enrollment. In-House Visitors and Field Trips are included in the tuition. Optional excursions will be an additional fee. Spaces are limited, there are no refunds or schedule changes after June 19th. All activities and excursions are subject to change.

Discounts 5 day programs with a minimum sign up of 5 weeks will receive a 10% discount if ½ tuition is paid by May 1st, 5% discount if ½ tuition is paid after this date.
