ALPHABET SOUP

(AGES 4+)

A reading program structured with the developmental capabilities of 4 and 5 year olds in mind. The children are trained in phonemic awareness and phonics and will learn to hear the distinct sounds contained in words, recognize the position of each sound, and associate these sounds with specific letters. They will learn sight words, be introduced to common blends and vowel teams and learn to love reading! The children will make take home vowel puppets, play games,

sing songs, "write" with alphabet blocks, make arts and crafts projects, and read take home books.

NUMBER CRUNCHERS

(AGES 4+)

Familiarize your child with basic math concepts that serve as the precursor to math in elementary school and that are aligned with the standards and goals contained in the California Preschool and Kindergarten Learning Foundations. The intent is to show the children that math is all around them, can be seen in everyday applications and is fun. The class is hands on and

is meant to be thought provoking. A primary focus is the number line which is the precursor to understanding addition and subtraction. Other areas of focus include math vocabulary, reasoning (i.e. extrapolation) and number sense. The concepts are presented through use of manipulatives, songs, games, and arts and crafts.
